

**LAGRANGE TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES**  
**September 22, 2008**

This was a regular meeting of the LaGrange Township Trustees. Burnett called the meeting to order at 7:00pm with Burnett and Ford present. Canfield was absent. Burnett motioned to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting; Ford seconded the motion, roll call – all yes.

**Public Participation**

Barbara Harper of Pheasant Run was present and informed the Trustees that the recent article in the Chronicle Telegram was inspired by a resident desiring some publicity and the article did not present all of the facts on the financial situation there. She stated that there are going to be some changes made but there are no plans to disband the association.

**Fire and EMS**

Chief Rader reported that the department responded to a barn being burned down too close to the house on Parsons Road.

**Zoning**

Sigmund reported that five permits had been given since the last meeting. New fence regulations have been passed by the State General Assembly which goes into effect on September 30. The Zoning Commission is reviewing road map revisions for the county. The Zoning Commission will hold a public hearing on October 20 on new regulations for driveway set backs. Vince is working with Lorain County Soil and Water on the Storm water Act. Eventually the area along creeks will not be allowed to have the land disturbed at all within a limited distance.

A newspaper article was reviewed about a cage fighting business possibly being started in the township.

**Fiscal Officer**

The approval of the financial reports for August was motioned by Burnett and seconded by Ford, roll call – all yes.

Ed Nau, seasonal road employee, has requested uniforms and he indicated that he would pay for them if necessary. Burnett felt that when he is working he is representing the township and should be in uniform as other employees. Burnett motioned to supply and pay for uniforms for Nau, Ford seconded the motion, roll call – all yes.

**CIC**

Burnett reported that the IRS penalty has been refunded. The doctor's office is open and operating and the Nursing Home held their Open House.

**LORCO**

Barb Harper noted that the last meeting was held at Eaton Township. She also reported on information given out at the last County Trustees Association meeting.

RLCWA

Harper presented the minutes for the August meeting and stated that there is no discussion relating to any new activity in LaGrange Township.
