

- A. Residential - The contractor shall provide for pickup including Garbage, Rubbish, disposal of Residential Refuse, Recyclable Materials from all single family, duplex and triple residences at the rate of one (1) collection per week, per Residential Unit. All refuse shall be placed in a container to be provided by the contractor at no additional cost to residents. Containers shall be no larger than 96 gallons in size, and residents shall have the choice of no less than three container sizes. All recyclable materials shall be placed in a recycling container to be provided by the contractor at no additional cost to residents. All recyclable materials shall be transported by the Contractor in a vehicle specially designated for recyclable materials only. Collection shall be at the rate of one (1) collection per week on the day designated for regular collection. Residents who have obtained a medical exemption from a certified physician that indicates an inability to use the container system shall be given a suitable alternative by the contractor.

The contractor shall designate one (1) collection week per month to collect bulky waste on the day designated for regular collection. In addition to one (1) collection week per month, the contractor shall also collect bulky waste during the last week of December and the first week of January as well as during the entire month of April. By the determination of the Contractor or at the request of the City, the Contractor shall collect bulky waste for a reasonable timeframe following an "Act of God" which necessitates expedient collection of bulky waste items. Each household shall be granted two "amnesty" collections per year in which they may contact the contractor to schedule a bulky waste pickup on their day of regular collection. The contractor shall collect yard waste from April 1<sup>st</sup> through November 30<sup>th</sup> as well as during the last week of December and first two weeks of January on the day designated for regular collection. Yard waste shall either be placed in brown paper yard waste bags or in plastic trash cans located next to the recycling container.

- B. Municipal Facilities - The contractor shall provide for the pickup and disposal of all Garbage, Yard Waste, Bulky Waste, Recyclable Materials and Rubbish Generated by the City. This service shall be rendered on a "no charge" basis to the City. Storage and Haul-Away Units shall be provided on the facilities. Where large Storage Units are not practical, containers may be used. The City shall determine the frequency and method of pick-up for the following:
1. City Hall and Police Station Complex
  2. City Service Garage
  3. All Fire Stations
  4. Water Works
  5. Sewage Treatment Plants
  6. All City owned Parks and Recreational Facilities
  7. Electrical Department
  8. Municipal Pier
  9. Health Department
  10. Garbage Receptacles on Broadway
  11. Such other facilities owned by the City as may be determined by the City from time to time
- C. Special Collections (Municipal) - The Contractor shall provide special collections of all types of Garbage, Rubbish, Yard Waste or Bulky Waste for the City at such

after the complaint is received. Contractor shall provide to the City an annual report listing all complaints including the nature and location of the complaint and the complaining party and the response made by the Contractor.

- F. Point of Contact - All dealings, contracts, etc. between the Contractor and the City shall be directed by the Contractor to the Office of the Director of Public Safety/Service, and by the City to the Dispatcher of the Contractor.
- G. Collection Equipment - The Contractor shall provide for an adequate number of vehicles for regular collection services. All vehicles and other equipment shall be modern and kept in good repair, appearance, and in a sanitary condition at all times. Each vehicle shall have clearly visible on each side the identity and telephone number of the Contractor.
- H. Office - The Contractor shall maintain an office equipped with sufficient local telephone lines and shall have a responsible person in charge from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on regular collection days.
- I. Hauling - All refuse hauled by the Contractor shall be so contained, tied or enclosed that leaking, spilling or blowing are prevented.
- J. Disposal - All refuse collected for disposal by the Contractor shall be hauled to a Disposal Site. The charge for disposal shall be included in the rate set forth in the Proposal for each Residential Unit serviced by the Contractor.
- K. Best Available Technology - (A landfill engineering design feature which employs the best current methods in construction, operation and maintenance of facilities in order to minimize negative environmental impact.) As described in OAC 3745 and 40CFR Subpart D, section 258 including such items:
  - 1. Composite liners consisting of recompacted soil and a geomembrane;
  - 2. A leachate collection system;
  - 3. A groundwater monitoring system;
  - 4. Upon closure, a composite cap.
- L. Disposal - All Residential refuse collected for disposal by the contractor shall be hauled to a B.A.T. landfill site. The charge for disposal shall be included in the rate set forth in the bid for each residential unit serviced by the Contractor.
- M. Recycling Process Center/ Yard Waste Processing - All commingled recyclable materials and newspaper recyclable materials collected in recycling containers by contractor shall be hauled to a materials recovery facility. (All yard waste materials shall be hauled to a compost facility.) The charge for processing materials and composing shall be included in the rate set forth in the bid for each residential unit serviced by the Contractor. The City of Lorain shall be provided up to 100 cubic yards of mulch free.
- N. Notification - The Contractor shall notify all resident producers and the City about complaint procedures, rates, regulations, and day for scheduled refuse collection.
