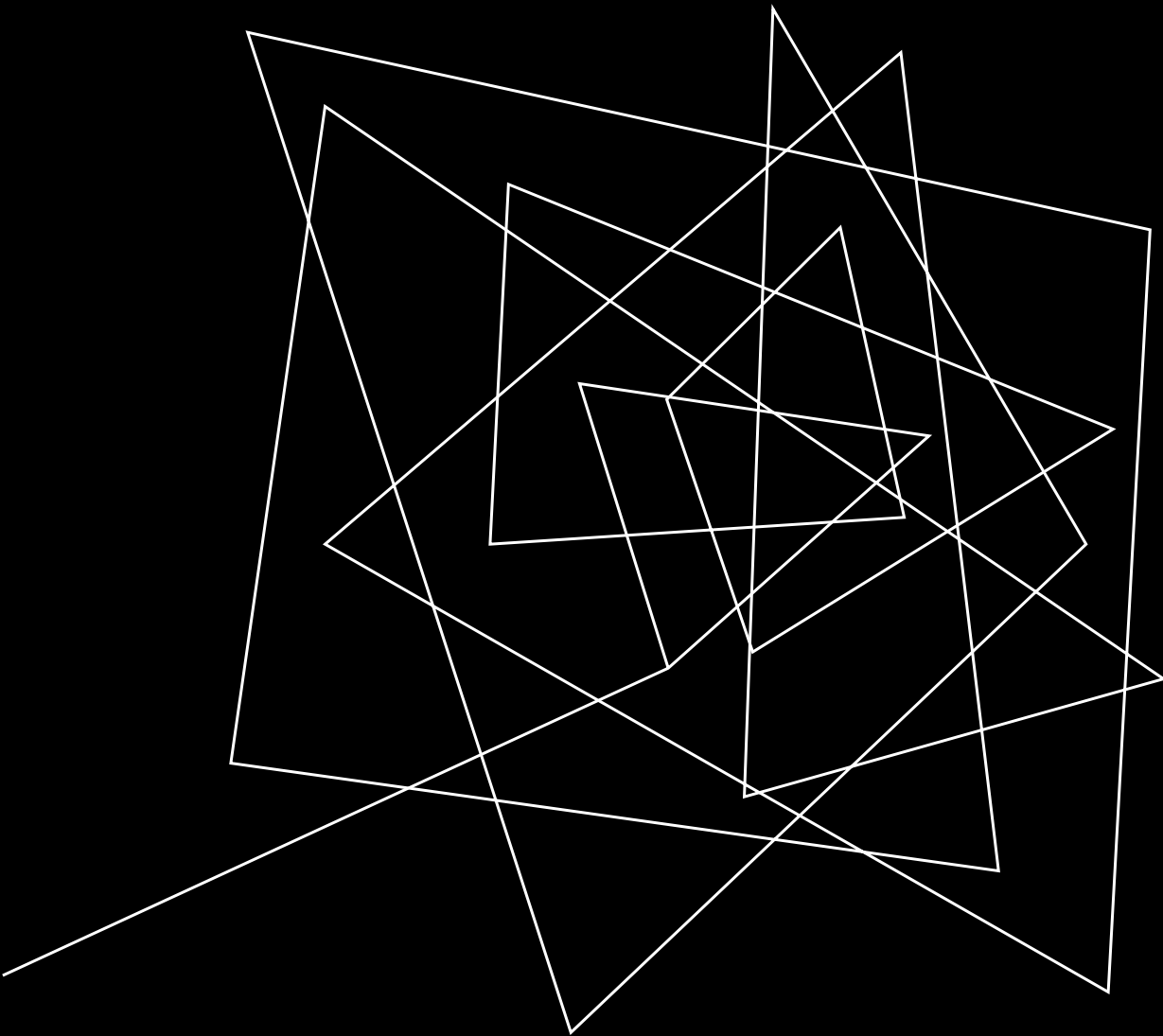

WHEREAS, The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said ³Grafton Township, Lorain County, Ohio; therefore be it

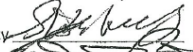
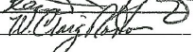
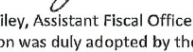
