PERMIT CRITERIA

Revised 9/27/2023

A Highway Use Permit shall be required when doing any utility work within the limits of the road right-of-way of any county or township road. This work shall include but not limited to:

- 1. Placing buried cable within the road right-of-way.
 - The utility shall be placed in a three (3) foot wide corridor adjacent to the right-of-way line.
 - a) If the installation can not be made in the three (3) foot corridor, a field review will be done, before the permit is issued, to determine if any deviation will be permitted.
- 2. Placing any pipe or conduit within the road right-of-way for the transmission of water, gas, etc.
 - Pipe or conduit for the transmission of gas, water or other liquids shall be placed in a three (3) foot wide corridor adjacent to the right-of-way line.
 - a) Any deviation from this must have prior approval from the County Engineer.
- 3. Installing any pipe or conduit under the roadway by boring or open cut.

The primary means of road crossing shall be by boring under the road and placing a casing or conduit. The utility will then be placed inside the casing.

Open cuts are to be an option only when:

a) Two (2) or more unsuccessful attempts to bore have been made and unfavorable soil conditions have been determined.

The decision to allow an open cut shall be made by the County Engineer.

- a) Bores and open cuts shall be a minimum of three (3) feet from the top of the casing to the roadway surface.
- b) Method of backfill of open trenches, crossing roads, shall be determined by the County Engineer.
- 4. Replacing or placing new utility poles within the road right-of-way
 - Placement of five (5) or more new poles or replacing five (5) or more poles, on any road, shall require a permit. These do not have to be consecutive poles.
 - a) Poles shall not be more than three (3) feet from the right-of-way line.
 - b) Old poles shall be removed on their entirety.

All permit applications shall be accompanied by a plan sheet(s).

All plans shall include the following:

- a) A distance from the edge of pavement (E/P) to the utility.
- b) Distance to the right-of-way line (R/W).
- c) Distance from E/P or centerline to all utilities.
- d) Location of any proposed bore pits, minimum distance from E/P not to be less than the (10) feet.
- e) Show suitable landmarks, side roads house numbers, etc.
- f) Show existing physical conditions, such as bridges, culverts, trees, signs, etc.
- g) Depth of proposed buried utility.

ANY DEVIATION FROM THAT OF THE APPROVED PERMIT SHALL REQUIRE APPROVAL BY THE COUNTY ENGINEER, OF ANY MODIFICATIONS, BEFORE WORK IS STARTED.

WORK DONE BEFORE A PERMIT IS ISSUED MY BE SUBJECT TO REMOVAL AND RECONSTRUCTION, AT THE EXPENSE OF THE UTILITY. AS DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY ENGINEER.

In new subdivisions, construct and complete all underground sanitary sewers, storm sewers, water lines, gas mains, electric and telecommunications conduits and service laterals or connections before the roadway paving operations begin. Provide sleeves under the pavement in advance as necessary. Boring, jacking, augering, and directional drilling methods of installation after the commencement of preparation of the subgrade shall be permitted only with the prior approval of the County Engineer. Open cutting of new pavements is prohibited.

WORK TO BE DONE UNDER THIS PERMIT

(See Sec. 5547.04 Ohio Revised Code) (See Sec. 153.64 effective July 26, 1982)

General Provisions Applicable to All Permits

The granting of this permit does not in any way abridge the right of the Board of the County Commissioners of Lorain County, in their jurisdiction over the county highways. If, in the process of any future work or for the benefit of the traveling public, it becomes necessary, in the opinion of the County of Lorain to order the removal, reconstruction, relocation or repair of any of the fixtures, or work performed under this permit, said removal, reconstruction, relocation or repair shall be wholly at the expense of the owners thereof, and be made as directed by the Lorain County Engineer.

Applicants are advised that townships within the County may have permit requirements for the township-maintained roads in addition to those set forth here-in. The Lorain County Commissioners assume no responsibility for the failure of the applicant to secure such applicable township permits.

The Lorain County Engineer shall act for and in behalf of the County of Lorain in the issuance of the carrying out of the provisions of all permits.

The Lorain County Engineer shall have full authority to ensure that the provisions of this permit are fully complied with retains the right to reject any materials or workmanship in the restoration of County Highway facilities. Failure on the part of the permittee to conform to the provisions of this permit will be cause for suspension, revocation or annulment of this permit as the County of Lorain deems necessary.

If the party or parties to whom this permit is issued does anything contrary to the orders of the Lorain County Engineer and, after due notice, fails to correct such work or to remove such structure or material as he or they may be ordered to remove, the Lorain County Engineer may, with or without notice, correct such work or remove such structures or material; and the party or parties to whom the permit is issued shall reimburse the Lorain County Engineer for any expense incurred in correcting the work or removing the structure or materials.

All the work herein contemplated shall be done to the satisfaction of the Lorain County Engineer, and the entire expense thereof shall be borne by the party or parties to whom this permit is issued.

Except as herein authorized, no excavation shall be made or obstacle placed within the limits of the highway in such manner as to interfere with the travel over the road.

If any grading, sidewalk or other work done under this permit interferes with the drainage of the highways in any way, such catch basins and outlets shall be constructed as may be necessary to take proper care of said drainage.

The acceptance of this permit or the doing of any work thereunder shall constitute an agreement by the party or parties to whom the permit is granted to comply with all of the conditions and restrictions printed or written herein.

All of the above conditions shall be applicable to the work herein authorized, unless the same are inconsistent with the conditions on the face of the permit, in which case the conditions written or printed on the face of the permit shall apply.

Highway property disturbed by the permittee shall be restored using materials, design and workmanship in conformance with the Lorain County Standards.

All pole lines are to be built in accordance with Administrative Order No. 72 of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.

All work requiring men or vehicles on the pavement or shoulders shall comply with all of the requirements of the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

Failure to comply with this requirement will be cause for immediate suspension of the permit until the proper traffic controls have been provided.

The permittee, upon completion of the work, shall leave the highway clean of all rubbish, excess materials, temporary structures and equipment, and all parts of the highway shall be left in acceptable condition.



8.	The performance guarantee shall be in the amount of \$5,000 for each road bore and \$1,000 for each 100 feet of roadside ditch disturbed, or in an amount approved by the Lorain County Engineer. This is to insure the complete restoration of any pavement, drainage, shoulder, structure, sod or other item disturbed by the permittee.
